She has prepared or co-prepared projects presenting hyperrealistic tendencies in Czech painting, the MUO collection of modern and contemporary graphic art, the SEFO 2021/2024 triennial of Central European contemporary art, the Otwock project by Mirosław Bałka and Kasia Redzis, and the work of László Lakner and Zdeněk Beran, among others. As an author, she has contributed to a number of publications, including the anthology New Realisms. Modern Realistic Approaches on the Czechoslovak Scene, 1918–1945 (1918-1945), Dutch New Architecture, Typography, Photography, Advertising, etc. She is co-editor of the magazines Umění 3/2022 and Profil 1/2018. She is interested in museum education, the principles of sustainability and inclusivity. She is a member of L'Association internationale des critiques d'art (AICA).
